BOOKSTORES STRUGGLE TO STAY OPEN

These are not easy times for bookstores. For many years they've had to deal with competition from Internet shopping sites, and now there is an additional threat: the growing popularity of e-books – electronic books that can be read on a computer screen. This situation has forced many bookstores to close down.

5 Others, like Mariner's Bookstore in Somerville, are doing their best to stay in business. Our reporter spoke with Freddy Mariner, the store's owner.

Why do you think e-books are so popular?

It isn't really surprising. Just think of the convenience: you buy an e-book on the Internet and within seconds you get it on your screen. In addition, you can
10 buy as many e-books as you like without having to worry where you're going to put them all. And most importantly, there's the matter of price. E-books don't need to be printed, stored, or delivered to bookstores, all of which cost a lot of money. Therefore, publishers are able to sell them at a much lower price than the printed version of the same book. All this is forcing bookstores to find new
15 ways to attract customers.

Such as?

Here at Mariner's, for example, we've started selling used books, which are obviously less expensive. Other stores are focusing on specific audiences, such as young children, who still prefer to hold a real book in their hands. And there
20 are also stores that are trying to improve their service: they train their staff to give customers more personal help, or provide readers with a quiet corner where they can get a cup of coffee and sit down to leaf through a book.

So do you think there's a future for bookstores?

I sincerely hope so, because I believe their disappearance would be a great
25 loss. After all, bookstores offer so much more than Internet shopping sites can. Many customers enjoy the unique experience of visiting a bookstore, and publishers use our window displays to bring their books to the public's attention. However, it's still unclear if the changes we're making will really enable us to survive. We're in the middle of a revolution here, and nobody
30 knows how it will end.
